

Summary of Ellen's Creek Watershed Group (ECWG) Activities  
June - November 2022

- ECWG coordinator, Emma Doucette, attended several training sessions (forestry training, WGIS training, living shoreline training, etc.)
- Hiring two students for 8 weeks to do activities to improve the watershed.
- Cleared watercress, collected litter, planted trees and monitored previous planting sites.
- Collaborated with PEIWA to remove glossy buckthorn and plant ~50 native saplings along the walking trail behind the WRCC.
- Held a successful indoor event for the Charlottetown SEAM group at UPEI.
- Assisted with Charlottetown Ecological Pond Study (water quality monitoring, sediment sampling, etc.).
- Maintained Charlottetown Living Shoreline site.
- Emma met with representative from TransCoastal adaptations to learn about coastal erosion assessment.
- Electrofishing survey.
- Strengthened connections with UPEI and Holland College
  - Hosting UPEI Environmental Studies intern,
  - Hosting 3 field trips for Holland College EAST program.
- Emma has been in contact with developers & environmental consultant with Hidden Valley subdivision development
- Collaborated with other watershed groups on field activities & training.
- Working with the City of Charlottetown & CBWES on the expansion of the Charlottetown Living Shoreline site.
